## YEAR 7 INDUCTION AND TEAM BUILDING PROGRAMME

We are happy to inform you that the Year 7 residential activity course to the Pioneer Centre in Cleobury Mortimer, that was planned to go-ahead the beginning of this term, will now be taking place on Wednesday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2022 and returning on Friday 14<sup>th</sup> January 2022. Fully trained and qualified instructors will provide instruction in a programme of activities in a safe, controlled and secure environment.

The students will take part in nine activities, which are likely to include those listed below:

- Abseiling
- High ropes • Archery
- Challenge Course
- Initiative Games
- Climbing Fencing
- **Raft Building**

These activities are very much aimed at providing fun and adventure for the children while, at the same time, enhancing the development of their personal and social skills. However, we have also tried to cater for children who prefer less challenging activities. The course is designed to develop team skills, and the children should benefit enormously from the experience. For these reasons, we feel it is important that as many children as possible take part in the visit.

The full cost of this trip will be £145.00 and this includes:
