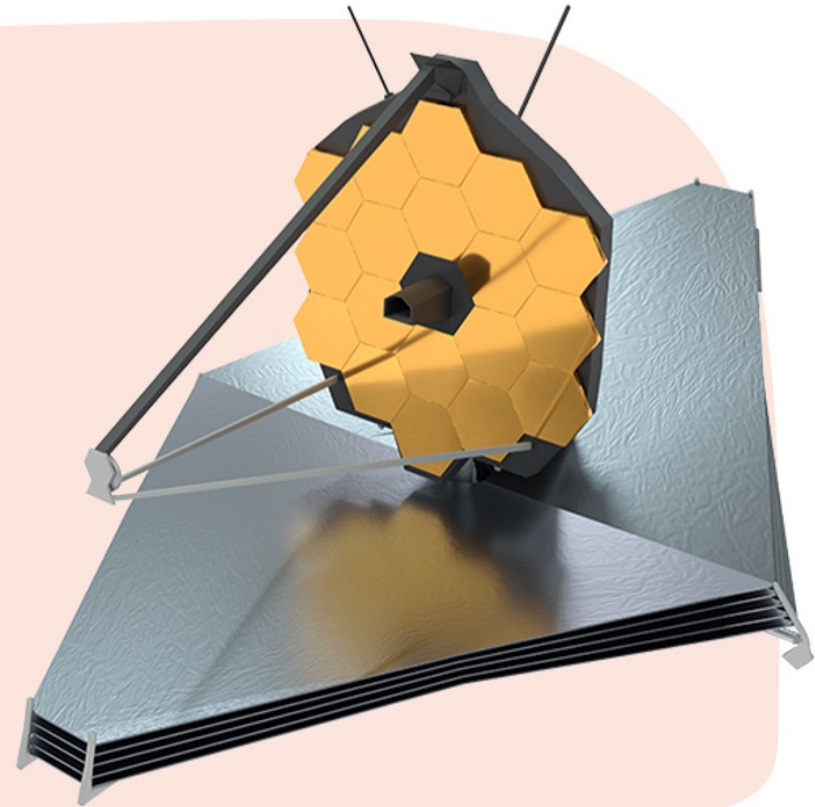

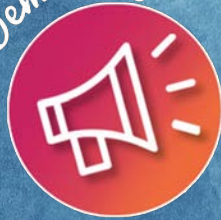

Tolerance

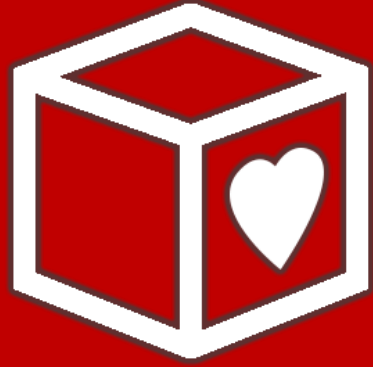
A fair, objective, and permissive attitude to those whose faith, religion and beliefs may differ from one's own.
