**Only students wishing to buy food from the canteen can access the school at this time and should do so through the main reception.**

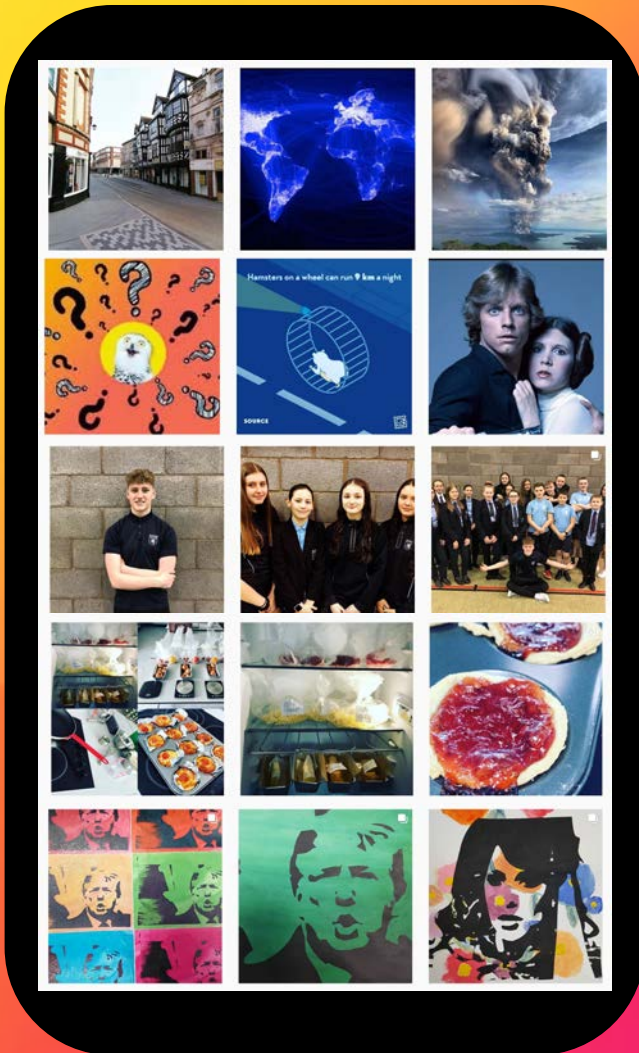

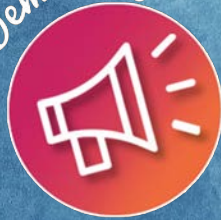

Tolerance

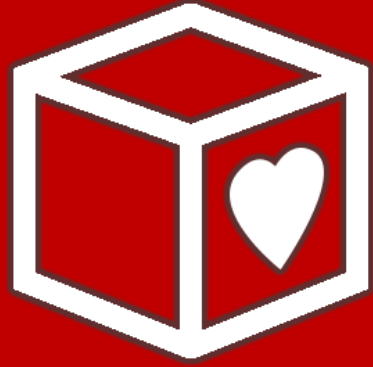
A fair, objective, and permissive attitude to those whose faith, religion and beliefs may differ from one's own.

We participate in The Red Box Project as we believe no young person should miss out on their education because they have their period and also know that emergencies can happen whilst in school.

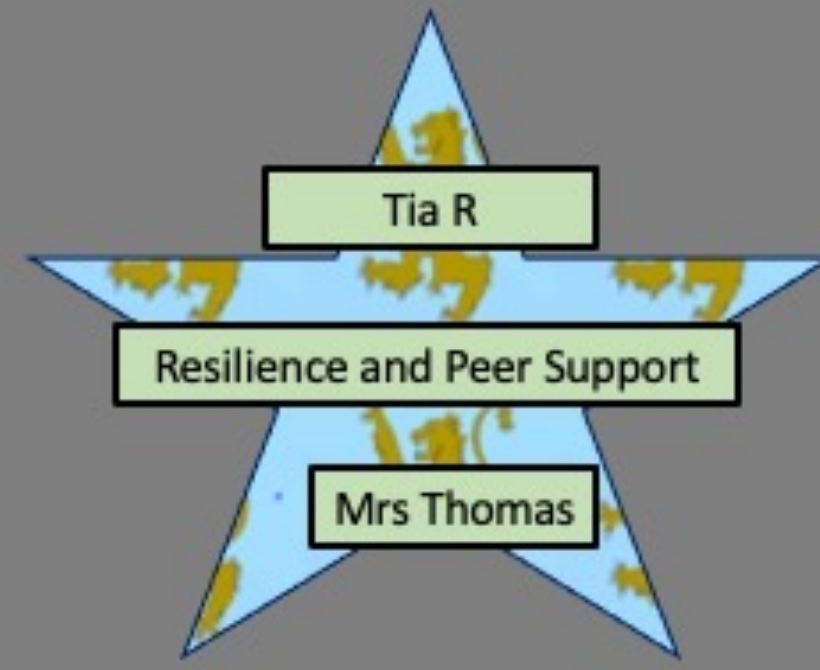
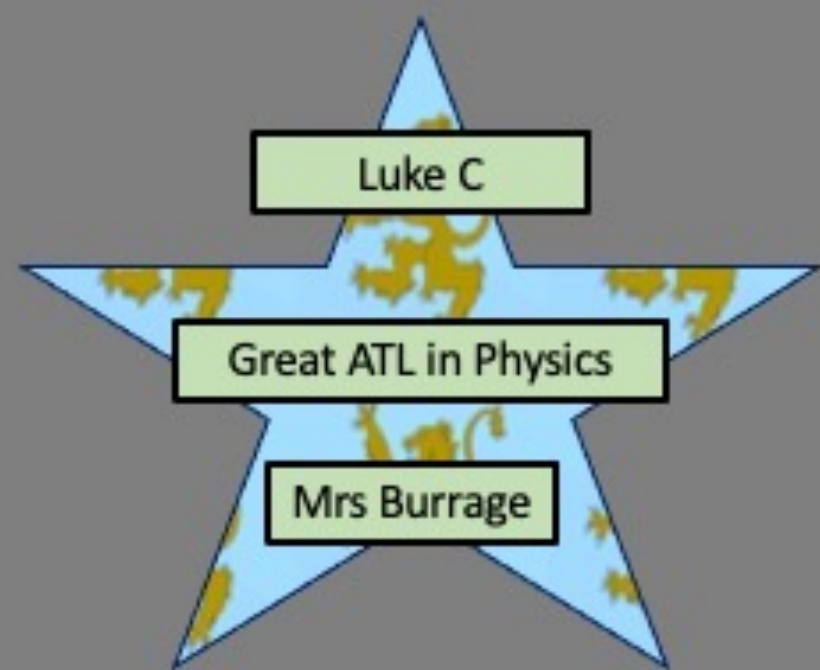
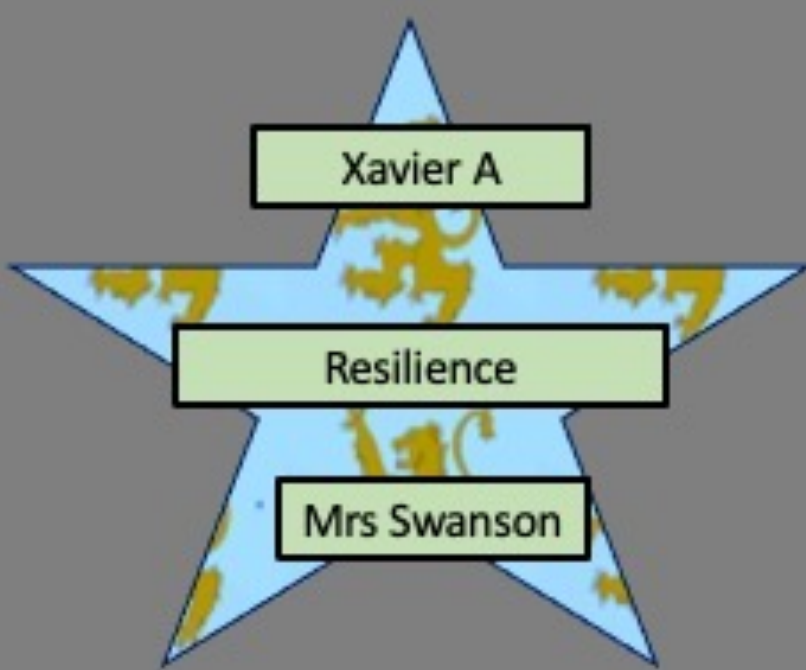
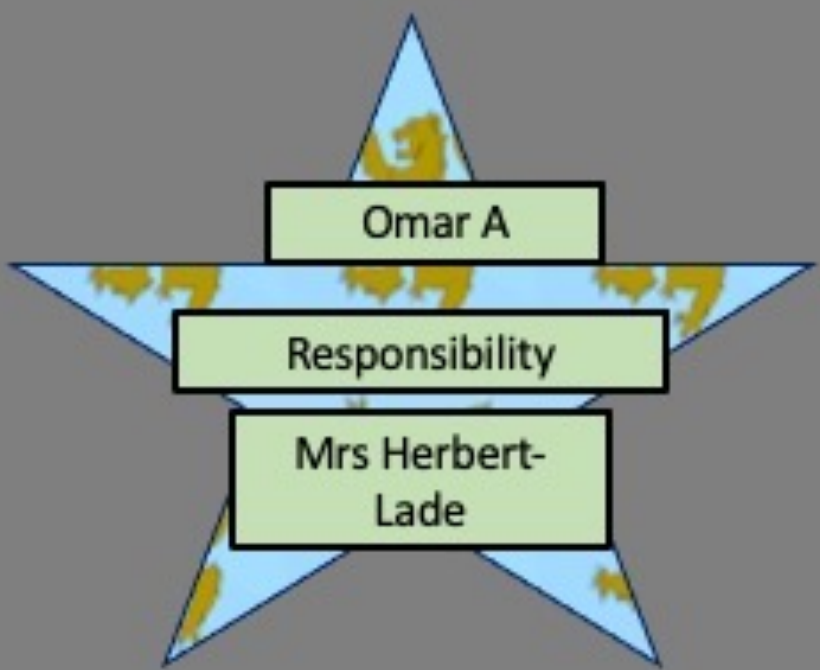
