Dear Parents/Carers

This is my first whole school letter to include our new starters for September 2021. We are disappointed to have not met you all yet but are really looking forward to seeing you at summer school and on our return for the Autumn term. Our school community welcomes you all.

As we come to the end of another busy year heavily impacted on by Covid-19, our attention turns to starting back in September and whilst we had all hoped for a restriction free return, the government have asked for testing to occur prior to students starting back.

We will be implementing a similar process to that in March where students will attend site to have the first of two Lateral Flow Tests and then return home. Doing this will prevent students starting school who are positive and will reduce the impact on others. It was very successful when we returned from the last lockdown.

Testing in this way will not further delay our planned return to school dates of:

Tuesday 7th September – Year 7 and Year 11 only Wednesday 8th September – All year groups

Please arrange for your child to attend school on the following days and times. They will be here for a very short period of time and will then return home. They should enter the building through the main reception:

We will conduct the second tests during school time on the following days:

- Wednesday 8th September -Year 7 and 11
- Thursday 9th September -Year 10
- Friday 10th September -Year 8 and 9

Following their second tests, students will be issued with a test kit box to allow them to undertake home testing until the end of September in the first instance. Please note that testing in school will be undertaken using the new Orient Gene Rapid Testing Kits, these are nasal swabs only, but the home testing kits are the original combined tonsil and nose swabs. I have shared links below, please discuss these with your child prior to them attending school for their test.

It is our understanding that the wearing of masks by staff and students will not be required after step 4 of the road map, this includes on the dedicated school's transport.
