We deliver consistent, high-quality teaching by subject specialists through the LCT framework, using research-based strategies from the science of learning to foster independent, resilient learners.

### Adaptive Teaching Strategies

PP students receive targeted support in lessons through adaptive teaching strategies and our Focus Five approach.



### Access to Targeted Academic Support

We provide extra support in reading and maths for students who need it, including programmes like Lexonik and small group tuition. These interventions are based on regular assessments to make sure we close any gaps and help every child succeed throughout their school journey.

### Revision Resources

All PP students starting GCSEs will receive free revision guides and access to structured revision sessions, including morning revision breakfasts during exams.



### Whole School Focus on Reading

We make reading enjoyable and meaningful by using engaging, age-appropriate books and focusing on building strong literacy and vocabulary skills across the whole school. Our goal is to help every child develop a lifelong love of reading.

### Form Tutor First Approach

Every child eligible for Pupil Premium has a dedicated form tutor who acts as their mentor and champion. They provide regular coaching and emotional support, understand any barriers to learning, and work closely with your child to make sure they have the help they need to succeed.



### Social and Emotional Support

Through the Emotional Health and Wellbeing pathway we are committed to ensuring that students receive the timely, proportionate and effective help needed to support through the challenges of being a young person growing up in an ever-changing society.



### Free One-to-One Music Lessons

Your child can enjoy 10 free one-to-one music lessons on an instrument of their choice. If they want to keep going, we'll help remove any financial barriers so they can pursue their passion.

### Guaranteed Enrichment Opportunities

Every Pupil Premium student will take part in at least one trip or enrichment activity each year to develop cultural capital every year, with financial support available to make sure cost is never a barrier. Opportunities include exciting experiences like an Outward Bound residential, theatre visits, historical sites, zoo trips, and theme parks. We monitor and track engagement in the variety of extra curricular activities across the academic year.



### Partnership with the Jon Egging Trust

We also work in partnership with the Jon Egging Trust, a charitable organisation that provide coaching and educational experiences for selected students.

### Student Voice

We make sure Pupil Premium students have regular opportunities to share their ideas and feel a strong sense of belonging at Charlton School. Through student leadership roles, surveys, action groups, and panels, their voices help shape improvements across the whole school.



### Support for Attendance and Engagement

We want every child to attend school regularly and thrive. To help with this, we use proactive strategies and personalised support plans. Our two dedicated Family Liaison Officers work closely with students and families, offering help both in school and at home to remove any barriers to attendance.

### Financial Aid

We don't want financial worries to stop any child from coming to school. If needed, we can help with uniform and essential equipment, so every student is ready to learn. We have strong links with our community services - Happy Healthy Active Holidays which enable Charlton students to receive Christmas food vouchers and free holiday camps.



### Parental Engagement and Support

Families will benefit from coffee mornings, parents' evenings, and pathways events, with targeted communication to support engagement and achievement.
